



## Statement on FOP #69 Interview

I declined the invitation to interview with FOP #69 after I discovered a Facebook post dated June 27 by its president, Dan Hils, which was aimed at denigrating Senator Sherrod Brown. I found the post offensive and derogatory. I am proud to have sought and received the endorsement of Sherrod Brown and, in good conscience, I cannot condone the divisive rhetoric used by Dan Hils in his post, which he signed “FOP #69, President.” Unfortunately, this was not the first time Dan Hils has used incendiary language that incites hatred. That’s not who I am, and, unlike my opponent, I cannot look the other way.
